verifying the volume and proper attribution of borrowed material using "Antiplagiat. Vuz" system



Clarify with your thesis supervisor the required percentage of
text originality for your faculty
Carefully review the text of your thesis: ensure all quotations
are properly formatted and enclosed in quotation marks.
The «Antiplagiat» algorithm only recognizes a quotation as
correct if it is placed in quotation marks with the source cited
immediately after the closing quotation mark
Submit the text in .docx, .rtf, or .pdf format to the responsible
staff member, thesis supervisor, or a librarian at the Research
Commons of the TSU Research Library. For checking the
document in the Research Commons, bring it on a USB flash
drive (not on a phone!!!) or save in advance in the Shared
Folder of the TSU Research Library, accessible from any
reader's computer in the library
Save the plagiarism check report in .pdf format
Show the report to your thesis supervisor
After receiving approval from your thesis supervisor, combine
the report (or the first page of the report) with the thesis text
and a scanned copy of the title page with signatures
Upload the thesis to the TSU E-library
